Re: Further Clarification for the Deployment of Heavy Plant Drivers (Port Workers).

Dear Sirs,

Further to our Public Notice No 20/12 dated 10th January 2012, please be advised that The Authority of Transport in Malta has advised that with <u>immediate effect</u>, the classification of the Heavy Plant Drivers as implemented under the Port Workers Regulations Part V Miscellaneous, has been further clarified by the Authority of Transport in Malta to be also applicable for <u>all vehicles</u> that are classified above the G.V.W of 3500kgs as per the C1, C+E, C, C+E categories of Vehicles for licensing purposes as classified in the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licence) Regulations.

Therefore, any additional costs applicable for the discharge/loading of these vehicles will be charged accordingly to the consignees/shippers.
